NEW ALBUM IN THE WORKS TO HELP TEACH CHILDREN WATER SAFETY SKILLS



Magical Music is excited to be embarking on a new project that not only "uses music to better the lives of to children," but will actually help save lives as well. Inspired by the songs from our album, A Day in the Life of a Child, and their ability to teach children daily life skills, Ailene Tisser from the Swim Angelfish Program, has asked Magical Music to write an album of songs that will help teach water safety skills. Swim Angelfish is an instructional swimming program with classes held throughout the northeast targeted for children with autism, physical difficulties and the sensory challenged.

"With drowning being the leading cause of death for children with autism, and the rate of autism increasing to 1 in 68, it is imperative that we get these children swimming," says Ailene. Music is a big motivator for all children and especially children with special needs. With catchy melodies and fun lyrics, the songs will teach safety skills such as the importance of NEVER going near water without an adult, how to instinctively always swim to the side of the pool, and how to float. There will also be songs about how to get children to feel comfortable in the water so that basic swimming strokes and skills can be taught.

As with our album, A Day in the Life of a Child, it is the goal of Magical Music to raise the money for the production costs of this new album so that it may be available as a FREE download for ALL parents, teachers, and children.
