When used to empower and evoke connectedness in children with autism and special needs, music is truly transformative.

- Our goal is to provide children of all abilities with music that engages and transforms the way they understand themselves, others, and the world around them.
- Magical Music is thrilled that the funds raised at TUNES IN TIMES SQUARE enabled us to complete our first album in the "Songs for Skills" program, a collection of free downloadable original songs written especially for children with special needs, and to tour a travelling show based on this album.
