Lyrical melodies, rhythms, and harmonies can elicit a response in children that stimulates learning, promotes responsiveness, encourages communication, and fosters growth. When used to empower and evoke connectedness in children with autism and special needs, music is truly transformative.

- Our goal is to provide children of all abilities with music that engages and transforms the way they understand themselves, others, and the world around them.
- **Magical Music** is thrilled that the funds raised at TUNES IN TIMES SQUARE enabled us to complete our first album in the “Songs for Skills” program, a collection of **free downloadable original songs** written especially for children with special needs, and to tour a travelling show based on this album.
