

# THANK YOU 2018



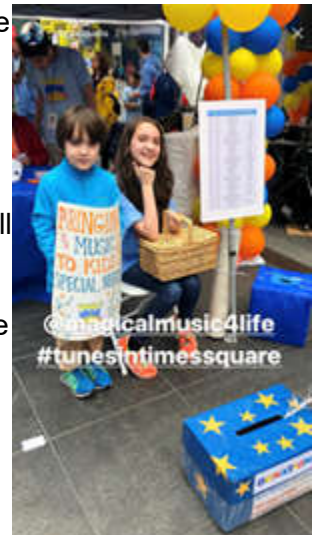
**We jumped for joy for all of you who participated in this great event!**
